Corporate Communication means any document to be issued by us for your information or action, including but not limited to (a) the directors' report, its annual accounts together with a copy of the auditors' report and, where applicable, its summary financial report; (b) the interim report and, where applicable, summary interim report; (c) a notice of meeting; (d) a listing document; (e) a circular; and (f) a proxy form.

You may choose any one of the following options in relation to Corporate Communications:

- (1) To agree to the Website Arrangement (i.e. to read the Corporate Communication published on the Company's website).
- (2) To receive a printed English version only.
- (3) To receive a printed Chinese version only.
- (4) To receive both the printed English and Chinese versions.

In order to save costs and protect the environment, we recommend you to take advantage of agreeing to the Website Arrangement. If we do not receive the Reply Form from you in relation to or your response indicating your objection to the Website Arrangement by 31 August 2009 and until you inform the Company or Computershare by giving reasonable notice in writing (as described above), you will be deemed to have agreed to the Website Arrangement.
